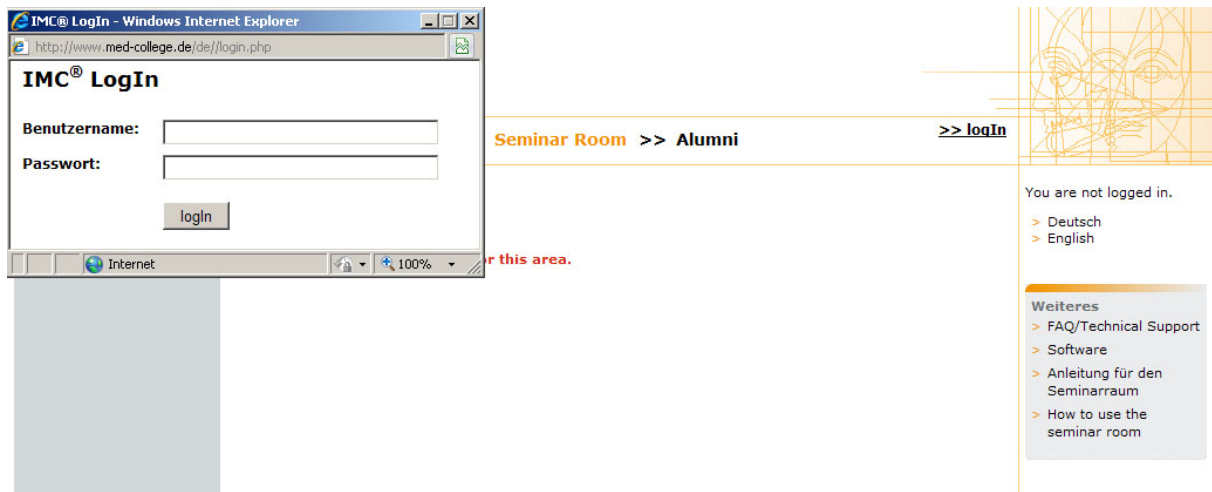



All articles are available in english and german language.







**Introduction**

Soft-tissue augmentation on the alveolar ridge is a reliable measure and was successfully adapted from plastic oromaxillofacial surgery as well as from periodontics for the use on implants. Soft-tissue augmentation is mainly indicated for permanent implant-supported dental replacements for phonetic, aesthetic, and improved hygiene reasons.

However:

With increasing numbers of surgical procedures, there are increasingly poor aesthetic outcomes secondary to scarring as well as the further development of "poor-quality" scar tissue.

**Timing of soft-tissue surgery**

Various soft-tissue defects can be treated in different therapy stages:

1. Before implantation (and also before conventional prosthodontic care)  
Possibilities for minimization of defects, infection prophylaxis (alveolitis) and preservation of the gingival contour:
  - Protective extraction technique to preserve the surrounding hard and soft tissue structures (q. v. **Example: Preservation of bone during extraction**)
  - Filling an extraction socket in the alveolus with collagen for the best possible preservation of the alveolar process volume and, therefore, the soft tissues.
